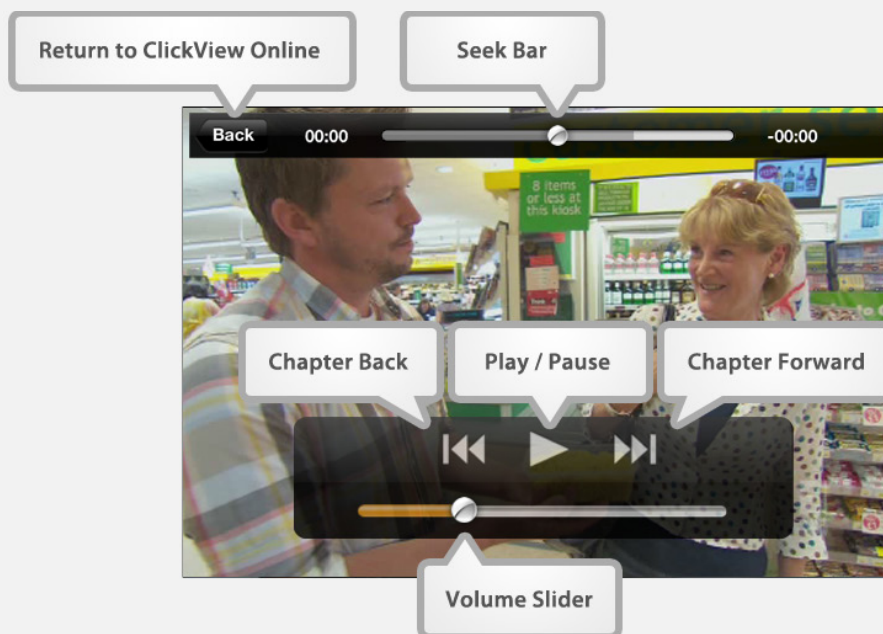


Introduction

The ClickView Player app for iOS allows you to watch videos from ClickView Online using your iPhone, iPad or iPod Touch. To browse videos from ClickView Online you will need an internet connection. It is recommended that where possible your device is connected to the same local network as the ClickView Library Server (via Wi-Fi). When this connection is present, video will stream using a stored local cache and load much faster.

To download the ClickView Player app, visit the App Store on your iPhone or iPad

ClickView Player video playback controls



Chapter Back / Forward

Skip forwards or backwards between chapters

Seek Bar

Touch and drag the handle to fast-forward or jump to a specific spot in the current chapter.

Play/Pause

Pause and resume video playback

Volume Slider

Touch and drag the handle in the volume slider to increase/decrease the volume

Back

Return to ClickView Online

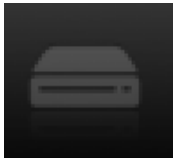


Playing a video

1. Open the Safari web browser
2. Enter **http://online.clickview.com.au** into the address bar
3. Sign-in with your username and password
4. Select **“My Library”**, **“ClickView Exchange”** (teachers only) or **“Favourites”** to browse the available videos
5. Select a video from the list by tapping on the video title,
6. On the video information screen tap the **“touch here to watch the video”** button to begin playback

Connection to ClickView Library Server.

This icon will display when a connection to a ClickView Library Server on a local network is present. Videos will stream significantly faster when connected to a Library Server.



Anonymous proxy settings

To connect to an anonymous proxy, from the main iPhone menu select **“Settings”** > **“Wi-Fi”** then select the network you wish to connect to by touching the blue arrow. At the bottom of the page select **“Manual”** and then enter your network proxy details.
